Role & Responsibility

An army of Volunteers are urgently required to help with the roll out and promotion of and various aspects of the QMS. They are needed for a variety of important jobs that need doing which involve the offering of time, expertise, efforts, use of resources, and philanthropic funding etc. A team of Volunteer Coordinators will take on the coordinating of the various teams of Volunteers required or take sole responsibility for a particular resource/aspect independently of a team.

Volunteers will need to provide information on how they are able to give to the QMS. This includes time, effort, skills and expertise. Some Volunteers may be able to provide philanthropic funding for various things, loan or hire resources for events at their expense, purchase promotional materials at their expense etc. Volunteers will need to provide their location and other key information to their Coordinator to help them manage their team effectively. Volunteers will work closely with their respective Coordinator who is the key contact point between them and the QMS Core Steering Team (liaising between the two). Once up-to-speed with what they are going to do, Volunteers will work in their own way toward the end result needed for the QMS and that all is done peacefully, altruistically and in harmony.

Volunteers will need to take ownership of their chosen area or resource and ensure that they do not take on more than what they are capable of fulfilling, are skilled in doing or of taking on too much work, etc. The QMS does not want anyone to be overloaded with whatever they take on, even though volunteers can take on more than one type of volunteering at their own discretion.

Volunteers will be required to work with their Volunteer Team Coordinator directly and not the QMS and will NOT be micro-managed.
